• Key Highlights:

- o Overall financials are on track with projections.

Discussion Points:

- Olarified distinction between "Events and Development" (e.g., galas) versus "Program Outreach" (e.g., local community engagements).
- o 88% of funds directly support programs and services, a strong metric to communicate to donors.

 - o Employee benefits increasing by 10%.

- o Community outreach initiatives, with higher travel and program expenses anticipated.

- o Reserve allocation of \$25,000 for operational flexibility.
- o Vehicle replacement planning for retreat logistics.
