- Little Pink is in its 15th years offering breast cancer patients and their families FREE weeklong retreats. Each retreat typically consists of 10-15 families that came from across the United States for a week of fun and relaxation. It offers a time for them to bond as a family unit as well as make new, life-long connections with other families on a similar journey.
- Little Pink prioritizes patients that are currently in active treatment for breast cancer.
- Families are housed individually made possible by a generous home donor and all of their meals and activities through the week are provided free of charge.
- The average age of participant attending is 38 years old. This is a busy time in a young mom or woman's life, often times juggling kids and work. Little Pink provides a respite to heal.
- Little Pink provides transportation assistance (flight, gas cards, rental car, etc.) for individuals with demonstrated financial need. We want to make sure that everyone can say yes to this amazing experience.
- Retreats are conducted in 8 states and the Virgin Islands. (current year list attached)
- Little Pink was founded by a breast cancer patient, Jeanine Patten-Coble after her own battle with cancer and is headquartered in Burlington, NC
- Volunteer opportunities are available for individuals who want to help volunteer on a retreat week; become a member of a local Team Pink in a specific retreat community; help collect auction items or be on a fundraising team, or conduct remote volunteer work. - Little Pink also offers a college scholarship program for children of patients who have attended a retreat.
- Local donations by businesses, churches, civic groups and individuals is what makes the retreat possible. If someone would like to make a donation, we would be honored.
